Through this report we try to put forward the new developments and achievements in Kinderhut Indonesia’s journey through the year of 2016”*

# Introduction

*“Children who cannot be looked after by their own family have a right to special care and must be looked after properly, by people who respect their ethnic group, religion, culture and language”*

*Article 20 - United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC)*

Kinderhut Foundation is driven by the strong belief in the right of orphan children to get care and protection. We the Kinderhut Foundation , strives to provide long-term systematic care of disaster victims, including orphan children and destitute women. It was before 11 years in August , 2005, Kinderhut Foundation have started its journey by establishing Kinderhut Village in Banda Aceh, Indonesia just after the deadliest ever recorded Tsunami hit the countries in Indian Ocean Region on 26<sup>th</sup> December 2004 and took more than 125,000 lives in the Aceh province itself.

By establishing Kinderhut Villages, we try to integrate orphan children and destitute women into a secure family environment in dedicated premises, and providing for their requisite individual needs including quality education, vocational training and domestic support.

Kinderhut Village, Aceh is now home for 109 children and 7 women which in turn meets their emotional, educational and security needs by providing familial atmosphere. Our vision is to provide home atmosphere to orphaned children and destitute women and creating opportunities for the children to get best education available and to raise the children into the leaders of tomorrow and assets for the local and global community.

Kinderhut Foundation is an International not-for-profit, non-governmental organization (NGO) registered in Indonesia and having branch office in Dubai. Kinderhut is managed and supported by a team of leading professionals and entrepreneurs of diverse nationalities, based both in the United Arab Emirates and in the organization's respective project sites across Asia. Kinderhut foundation is also a member of the International Humanitarian City- Dubai, the world's largest logistic center for humanitarian assistance activities. The activities of Kinderhut Foundation is of non-sectarian character and strives for the rehabilitation of orphan children in the spirit of *United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC)*.

## Achievements - Scholastic

## Our children into Prestigious Residential Schools

### ***Tgk. Chiek Oemar Diyan Modern Islamic Boarding School***

*Tgk. Chiek Oemar Diyan Modern Islamic Boarding School, is one of the most prestigious and old residential schools in Aceh. This year, we are overwhelmed by the admission of five of our children into this prestigious school. They have got admission after going through multi stage assessment. Rajarullah, Muhammed Khalisullah, Fouzul Kabir, Algi Fahri and Ismail are the children who got admission. They are admitted to Grade 7 and they will study there till they finish Grade 12.*

### ***SMA Negeri 1 Unggul Ali Hasjmy Boarding School***

SMA Negeri 1 Unggul Ali Hasjmy Boarding School, is the best senior secondary level boarding school in Aceh Besar Regency. Like previous year, again, two of our children got admission in the school. Ismunandar and T. Fakhrul Razi got admission into Grade 10. Presently our children Sabri and Darul Iman is studying in Grade 11 in the same school.

## *Metro TV Scholarship Program for Higher Education*



Horizons of the dream for higher education of our children are getting developed year by year. This year, two of our children, Elisa and Maya, have achieved a new milestone by reaching the final stage of selection for Higher Education Scholarship offered by Metro TV Indonesia. They have cleared the first two stages and attended the final selection procedure at Jakarta for getting full scholarship to study at University Ahmad Dahlan , Yogyakarta. Unfortunately, they couldn't clear the last stage. Reaching the last stage itself is a big achievement for the children. It has to be specially mentioned that, they were the only students selected for the last stage from entire Aceh Province.

## Achievements - Co-scholastic

### Gold Medal at Taekwondo Festival Conducted by Indonesian Youth and Sports Ministry



Kinderhut Taekwondo team participated in the Taekwondo Festival Conducted by Indonesian Youth and Sports Ministry on 24<sup>th</sup> April 2016. Our team have exhibited an exemplary performance and bagged three gold medals. Qurrata A'yun , Zakiaturrahmi, Nur Daesfi R Putri are the medal winners.

A team of 22 children participated in the 2016 Dandim 0101/BS Cup Taekwondo Open Tournament for entire Sumatera Region conducted by the Indonesian Military from 21<sup>st</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2016.



Three of our children, Qurrata A'yun , M Reza, Nadhifa Hafizdha have bagged Bronze Medals in the tournament which had a total 409 participants

# Collaborations - Governmental

## Ministry of Social Affairs, Indonesia

We are collaborating with the Ministry Social Affairs, Indonesia, from the time inception of Kinderhut Indonesia itself. During the year 2016 also we have received ample support and guidance from the Ministry through Department of Social Affairs , Indonesia.

This year we have received assistance from the Ministry in the form of food materials and other materials for children such as school bags, sandals, clothing items etc. They are also providing time to time training and guidance for the administrative staff of Kinderhut Indonesia on various aspects of Child Care Taking and Administration of Child Care Institutions.

## Board of Women Empowerment and Child Protection, Aceh

During the year 2016, we have developed a strong association with the Board of Child Protection and Women Empowerment, Aceh. We are providing care and protection for vulnerable children identified by the Board , who satisfies our criteria of admission. The Department have organised training sessions on the topics Child Rights and Effective Communication for the mothers of Kinderhut Village, Indrapuri.

## Knowledge Human Development Authority, Dubai

The long standing collaboration of Kinderhut Indonesia and Knowledge Human Development Authority, Dubai have reached new heights during the year 2016. Three teams of volunteers, have visited Kinderhut and organized training programmes for children and mothers of Kinderhut. Also with the KHDA Volunteers fund we have fulfilled some major immediate requirements in Kinderhut Village , Aceh.

### **KHDA Volunteers Visits**

- **30<sup>th</sup> January 2016 to 5<sup>th</sup> February 2016**

A team of 7 volunteers from KHDA visited Kinderhut from 30<sup>th</sup> January to 5<sup>th</sup> February. They have conducted various sessions for children. The sessions included Visual Harvesting, Mind Mapping, Story Telling, CV Preparation, Money Management, Infographics etc. The children enjoyed the training and were very much fruitful for them. Volunteers also conducted sessions for mothers as well for the Ustad.

## KHDA Volunteers Visits

- 19th to 25th March 2015

A team of 6 volunteers from KHDA visited Kinderhut from 19<sup>th</sup> to 25<sup>th</sup> March, 2016 . They have conducted various sessions for children including Visual Harvesting, CV preparation, financial management, craft making, etc. The sessions resulted in making children more energetic and ambitious. The sessions for mothers, including waste management and healthy food habit were very much useful and the discussion sessions on sustainable income generation with administration staff have given new insights and ideas which can be useful for Kinderhut in near future.



## KHDA Volunteers Visits

- **16<sup>th</sup> to 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2016**

The third team of volunteers from KHDA consisting of 5 members visited Kinderhut during July 2016. During this visit, a continues mothers training program was started. In addition to that, sessions on visual harvesting, mind mapping, career planning, etc. were conducted. The members of the team also had conducted an evaluation of Kinderhut Village and have provided an evaluation report citing the various areas where Kinderhut Village have to bring positive



## **KHDA Volunteers Fund**

Kinderhut have received a Fund from KHDA volunteers for purchasing some immediate requirements in Kinderhut Village, Indonesia. Following are the items purchased or installed using KHDA Volunteers Fund

- **Garbage Segregation Bins**

In order to segregate the garbage generated from each house we have purchased garbage segregation bins. Now each house have separate bins for food, plastic and paper garbage. Around the campus we have separate bins for plastic, paper and broken glasses.

Now the plastic garbage and broken glasses are collected separately and disposed of at government allotted garbage collection points. The organic food wastes are disposed of organically inside the campus in specific waste pits.

- **Laundry Baskets**

In order to keep the houses nice and tidy, we have added more laundry baskets in houses using the KHDA Volunteer Fund. One new baskets have been provided to each house



- **Water Jet Pump and Water Tanks**

Lack of proper pressure in water supply line was a major issue faced by us. In order to solve this issue we have installed new water jet pump in bore well near water tank tower in Kinderhut. We have also replaced two old water tanks in Kinderhut with new ones of capacity 3100 Liters each.



- **Reverse Osmosis Water Filter Unit**

Safe drinking water was always a concern in Kinderhut. For ensuring Safe drinking water, we have installed a Reverse Osmosis Water Filtering Unit using KHDA Volunteers Fund. The unit has a filtering capacity of 60 Gallons /day and a storage capacity of 1000 liters.

# Children's Initiatives

## Vegetable Farming

The Children of Kinderhut Village Indrapuri have taken up vegetable farming at the campus on their initiative. They are doing it by dividing themselves in groups and allocating specific areas for each group. The mothers are guiding them in this activity



## Aquaponics

*Children are doing an Aquaponic project under their initiative, using an previously, abandoned water tank in the campus. They have repaired and cleaned the tank and using it. A group of 9 children is behind this project, which is in an experimental phase now.*



## Aquaculture

*Aquaculture or fish farming is one of the exciting and new initiative taken up by the children under the leadership of Irfan and Bakri. We now have two fish tanks, in which fish are grown.*



## Waste Management Campaign

*Waste Management , especially, plastic waste management was one among the major challenges that Kinderhut have encountered recently. Our children have taken up this matter and formed committees to deal with this issue. On first phase they have conducted an awareness program about the ill effects of plastic wastes and the need for waste segregation and proper management. At this stage they have also made, waste bins using locally available materials , for the purpose of making children practice the act of waste segregation. On the next phase, when we have purchased new waste bins for waste segregation, the committee have marked each bins with specific writings and conducted one more campaign to familiarize the children and mothers about the new bins and the proper way of waste segregation.*



## Social Service Activities

*Under the initiative of children, Kinderhut Village, Indrapuri have conducted Social Service activity in the community. Public road, Indrapuri Old Masjid, Play School and other Government Institution near Kinderhut were cleaned by the children as part of the Social Service Activities.*



# Training and Development

## Mothers Training under the initiative of Ms. Bochra Kaddoura, KHDA, Dubai

*Exclusive training sessions of Child Development and Care is being conducted for Mothers in Kinderhut , Indonesia under the Guidance of Ms. Bochra Kaddoura , Senior Bilingual Inspector, Knowledge & Human Development Authority, Dubai. The first few sessions were handled by Ms.Bochra itself while she was visiting to Kindehut Village during July 2016. The follow-up sessions being implemented in Kinderhut by empowering local trainers through online guidance by Ms. Bochra . The sessions are based on pre-documented module and all the sessions are being recorded and consulted with Ms. Bochra.*

# Infrastructure Development

## Masjid Construction

*For years we were using a traditional wooden structure with temporary roof as Masjid . It was our long cherished dream to build a permanent building for Masjid in place of the old structure. This year we could start the construction of a new Masjid. The construction is expected to be completed within the first quarter of year 2017.*



## Play items

*We could install new play items for recreational purposes in our campus during this year. We have removed the old rusted play items and replaced it with a swing with 3 seat capacity, a slide and a monkey bar. Children enjoy playing in these new installations, especially the swing.*



## Water Filter

*Under our continuous efforts to ensure the quality of life of children, this year we have achieved a major milestone. As part of ensuring a healthy living in the Kinderhut village , we have installed a new Reverse Osmosis water filter in our campus , which can provide safe and pure drinking water to the all who stays in the Kinderhut Village campus. The filtering unit have a capacity to filter 60 Gallons /day with a storage capacity of 1000 liters at a time.*
