executive summary



The Kinderhut Foundation is an International NGO (Non-governmental organization), registered in Indonesia. gives primary interest in the long-term systematic care of disaster victims, including orphan children and destitute women, by integrating them back into a secure family environment in dedicated premises and providing for their requisite individual needs, including quality education, vocational training and domestic support.

The year 2012 was major breakthrough for Kinderhut Indonesia. This year the Kinderhut Indonesia has been selected as the best orphanage in Aceh Province. Followed by the selection by the Social department the organization has been selected from Aceh to represent to Jakarta for National contest. Towards qualitative improvement among children, this year Kinderhut took a proactive step

executive summary

The foundation set up the first Kinderhut Village for orphan children and destitute women in Banda Aceh, Indonesia, one of worst hit Tsunami areas in the world. The institution today is home to over 111 children and 14 mothers (destitute women); fulfilling their every requisite need, from education to vocational training and from rehabilitation to reintegration into family structures. Instead of an orphanage, we provide homes to the children bringing the lost confidence in the aftermath of tragedy.

The Kinderhut Foundation is managed and supported by a team of leading professionals and entrepreneurs of diverse nationalities in the United Arab Emirates and respective project sites. The organization is non-sectarian in character and works for the rehabilitation of children in the spirit of the U.N. Convention on the Rights of the Child. The Kinderhut International has a branch office at the International Humanitarian city.

This report deals with the major achievements in the year 2012.

basic education

In Kinderhut Indonesia the children are living from 4 years to 18 year of range. This year 5 small kids enrolled in the educational institution (Kindergarten TK Indrapuri) nearby its location for formal education. 10 elder boys joined in boarding schools, 5 are in Abu Lam U Boarding School and 5 in Fajar Hidayat Boarding school. All their educational needs meet by Kinderhut and monitor their studies by visiting them regularly.

The senior most elder boy, **Isjuardy** is studying in Vocational Higher Secondary school (SMK) Banda Aceh in Automobile trade.

The majority of Kinderhut children depends Indrapuri Village for their Schooling. There are 5 children studying in Kindergarten, 66 children are in elementary school, 36 children are in junior high school and 4 children are in Senior High School. All are day scholars except the boarding school children. This academic year there are 7 elder girls have been selected for Ingin Jaya, one of the best junior high schools in Banda Aceh. Among them Irhamna, one of the bright student, selected for best class and continuing her studies.

The Ingin Jaya, Junior School SMP, is located around 18 km away from Kinderhut. Kinderhut arranged transportation for them on daily basis to continue their studies.

This year has a speciality that many of Kinderhut children have been selected for best institutions for higher studies. Therefore Kinderhut is looking forward towards their bright future by emphasizing quality education for the beneficiaries.

teach a class

To improve the quality of education among children Kinderhut Indonesia is associated with a US based NGO, Teach A Class, this year. The team of Teach A Class visited Kinderhut in August 2012 to train the teachers and volunteers. The Wi-Fi Educational Hotspot has been set up at Kinderhut by the Teach A Class. The children can access video materials through this hotspot. The Nomad Edu and Khan Academy materials are available through the hotspot right now.

Using laptops the children of Kinderhut prepare their lessons especially for Mathematics & English with the help of Teach A Class. They can practice their lessons and can assess their performance by utilizing this facility.

Every day the Teach A Class being taught in Kinderhut with the help of trained teachers. The Khan Academy video materials being translated into Bahasa Indonesia. It will be benefitted the whole student community of Indonesia in the near future.

health

HHealth and personal hygiene is one of the major areas of concern among the beneficiaries. Kinderhut Indonesia provides immediate medical care and support as per the need. In addition to this emergency medical services, Kinderhut Indonesia conducts medical check up once in every three months. This year Kinderhut Indonesia associated with **International Channel Foundation** to conduct medical camps.

community service

To sensitize with community the Kinderhut gives opportunity to its beneficiaries for community services by the active involvement of community people. This helped to create an exposure to the community and the feeling of togetherness in their minds. Kinderhut Indonesia conducts the community service programme once in every three months. This year they selected public road, Indrapuri Old Masjid area and Indrapuri Market places etc. Children, care takers and staff actively involved in this process. During the cleaning process they created awareness about the evils of plastics and the ways of disposing it.



recreation

To have an entertainment and enjoyment among beneficiaries kinderhut conducts recreational activities once in every three months. There were various places selected for recreational activities for this year such as natural water resource areas, beaches, dam sites and water theme park etc. The children, care takers and staff enjoyed the recreational activities as well. The boarding school children also joined in the recreational programmes.



martial arts

This year Kinderhut started martial arts training in its campus for children. They practice Taek Wondo under a qualified trainer. There are 20 children participating in this programme. There are 3 sessions per week. Boys & Girls enthusiastically participating in this art. Kinderhut could send children to participate in a state level competition of Taek Wondo and bagged 2nd and 3rd place. **Dea Ananda** got silver medal and **Nur Aida** bagged bronze medal in the competition conducted in December 2012 at Banda Aceh.

care takers

Care takers play an important role in Kinderhut to meet the regular day to day needs of children. There are 11 care takers and 3 assistant care takers at Kinderhut right now. Kinderhut select deserving care takers by considering their family background. They are destitute women and therefore they are beneficiaries of Kinderhut too. Kinderhut taking care of their food, shelter, health and rehabilitation.

This year Kinderhut conducted various training sessions for their development. It is conducting moral classes and training in every week and conducts weekly meeting with them to assess their performance and children's development.

This year the care takers undergone training on parenting, hygiene & sanitation by health department, rights & justice for children by police department, cookery training by Deepa, a volunteer from Dubai, relaxation & anger management by Abhishek, a volunteer from Dubai & leadership training by a team of volunteers from Dubai.



library

This year Kinderhut Indonesia opened library facility of the children in its campus with limited facility. Each child has provided with library card. Every day from 4.30 pm to 6pm the library opens. The librarians have been selected among the children and given schedule accordingly. The kinderhut received books from well wishers & philanthropist. Recently the library is functioning in the temporary class room nearby the office.

Kinderhut children participated in various extracurricular activities conducted by government and non government institutions. Ayu Firdaliani got 3rd Price In a literature competition in Junior High School level conducted by an NGO dedicated for literature.
